Venues: UBC Okanagan (UBC O) 3333 University Way, Rutland Senior Secondary (RSS) 705 Rutland Rd N (please use rear entrance of RSS on Dodd Road)

George Elliot Secondary (GESS) 10241 Bottom Woodlake Rd, Winfield, Immaculata (IMM) 1493 KLO Road

Format: In pool play each team plays 2 sets to 25 against their opponent and playoff matches are best 2 of 3.

Playoffs: Girls - Heat Division Playoffs - The 8 teams from Tier 1 and the 1st and 2nd place teams from Tier 2.

Girls - Blue Division Playoffs - 3rd, 4th & 5th place teams from Tier 2. 5th place in pool F will play 2 consolation matches on Saturday at 1:15 and 2:20.

Boys - Gold Division Playoffs - The 6 teams from Tier 1 and the 1st and 2nd place teams from Tier 2.

Boys - Silver Division - 3rd and 4th place teams from pools K,L,M will be re-pooled then will have a cross over placement match.

Pool standings and records will be determined by ratio of sets won/lost overall, then sets head to head between tied teams, points overall, and continue with VC tie break rules.

Warm-up: Teams will be guaranteed a 6 minute (3 & 3) warm-up in pool play, 10 minutes (5 & 5) in playoffs.

Officiating: UBC Okanagan Student-athletes will be officiating most of the matches during the event and they have been trained. One "up" official for each match, two when possible.

Teams will be responsible for providing 1 linesperson and 1 scorer for each of their OWN games. This could be players on the bench, parents, friends, etc.
